Rule #1: You can only work on two merit badges at a time.

During this crisis, the procedures to follow are:

- 1) Scout commits to doing the merit badge.
- 2) Scout reaches out to the Advancement Chair (Mr. Finlayson) for contact information for merit badge counselor.
- 3) Scout reaches out to Counselor via email and gets approval to begin work with the Scout on the merit badge.
- 4) Scout contacts Scoutmaster for blue card.
- 5) Scoutmaster fills in blue card, signs it and holds it in his files.
- 6) Scoutmaster contacts Counselor, lets the Counselor know the Scout has the approval of the Scoutmaster to work on the merit badge and asks the Counselor to keep an electronic record of the scouts progress.
- 7) Scout works with counselor on the merit badge.
- 8) When complete, the Counselor informs the Scoutmaster the scout has completed the merit badge.
- 9) Scoutmaster completes the blue card.
- 10) Scoutmaster returns completed blue card to Advancement Chair.
